

## 3 POSITIVE IMPACTS OF eBOL





Electronic transmission of bill of lading information dramatically reduces the risk of human error and issues down the road.

- Fewer changes due to reweigh or reclass

## **IMPROVED SERVICE**

Electronic bill of lading (eBOL) enables carriers to tie together critical shipment identifiers including: quote ID, pre-assigned pro# and bill of lading # in advance of the pickup request.

- Carriers can accurately plan and send the correct equipment for pickup
- Linehaul routing begins sooner, which means earlier freight visibility
- Shipments move from origin to destination with less friction



Moving to a digital, paperless electronic bill of lading (eBOL) can make a significant impact on costs and the ecosystem.

- Shippers can expect to see 2% 4% cost savings per shipment\*
- Carriers estimate a 1.3% savings to current costs\*
- Reduction of paper is more environmentally friendly
